### What is the aim of a Project Compassion talk?

(You might even like to offer to arrive early and distribute the leaflets and envelopes yourself!)

*\*For example, if you are talking at mass, is it during the homily time of after communion? Introduce yourself to the Priest or parish reps before mass to be part of the procession.*
