Resource		Description / Suggested Use
For Teachers	Teacher Handbooks	Available in Lower Primary , Upper Primary and Secondary versions, provides an explanation of the Project Compassion resources. Briefly explores the curriculum and learning opportunities within Project Compassion.
For Students	Lower primary: Photo Storybooks	A Photo Storybook for each Project Compassion story, designed especially for Primary (F-2) students
	Upper primary: Online Student Zone	An interactive image with films, photos, stories and information for students to use to complete their student workbook.
	Upper primary: Student Workbook	A printablefillable PDF. Tasks include: Fact Check, Map, Global Goals (Sustainable Development Goals), Prayer and Reflection.
	Colouring Pages	Use these colouring pages to promote Project Compassion by creating a classroom or school display or using them for a colouring competition to raise money for Project Compassion.
	Audio Described Stories	A story for each week with included audio descriptions for students who are blind or have a visual impairment.
	Secondary: Student Workbook	A fillable PDF for students to record their learning and reflections as they journey through Project Compassion's online Deep Dive.
	Secondary Deep Dive	An interactive image with links to stories and information to help students complete their student workbook.
	Caritas Q & A	A chance to interact online with Caritas Australia Programs staff. 30-minute sessions hosted by Caritas Australia on Zoom. A unique opportunity for students to connect with Caritas-supported programs and to learn more about the impact of their generous donations. Registrations open to Years 4–12 class groups and available across all time zones.

Prayer and Reflection	Ash Wednesday Liturgy	<p>Available in Primary and Secondary versions, this Liturgy of the Word includes distribution of the ashes.</p>
	Prayer (PPT)	<p>The Project Compassion prayer with beautiful images. Use as a daily or weekly prayer for students or staff, or at an assembly.</p>
	Weekly Scripture Reflections for Teachers	<p>Weekly reflections for staff, linking the Project Compassion stories to the Sunday Scripture readings. Use for weekly staff reflections during Lent or with secondary students.</p>
	Way of the Cross (PPT)	<p>Available in Primary or Secondary versions. A reflection following the Way of the Cross to use during Holy Week. Leaders' Notes included.</p>
Telling Others	Newsletter Notices	<p>A brief insert for your weekly school newsletter, explaining the week's Project Compassion story. Include in print/online school communications. Use on school social media and website.</p>
	Social Media Toolkit	<p>Content and assets to share your support of Project Compassion through your social media channels.</p>
