	Resource	Description / Suggested Use
For Students	Upper primary: Pilgrim Pathways Journal (Student workbook)	A printable/fillable PDF journal (workbook) where students record their work as they encounter, learn, reflect, pray and take action to <i>Unite Against Poverty this Lent</i> .
	Upper primary: Pilgrims Place (Online student zone)	An interactive image with films, photos, stories and information for students to use to complete their Pilgrim Pathways Journal.
	Photo Storybooks	A Photo Storybook for each Project Compassion story, designed especially for Primary (F–2) students.
	Colouring Pages	Use these colouring pages promoting Project Compassion by creating a classroom or school display, or by using them for a colouring competition to raise money for Project Compassion.
	Audio Described Stories	A story for each week with included audio descriptions.
	Secondary Student Workbook: Pilgrim Journal	A fillable PDF for students to record their learning and reflections as they journey through Project Compassion as <i>pilgrims of hope</i> .
	Secondary Virtual Pilgrimage	An interactive image with links to stories and information to help students complete their student workbook (Pilgrim Journal)
	Caritas Q&As	A chance to interact online with Caritas Australia Programs staff. 30-minute sessions hosted by Caritas Australia on Zoom. A unique opportunity for students to connect with Caritas-supported programs and to learn more about the impact of their generous donations. Registrations open to Years 4–12 class groups and available across all time zones.

	Weekly Scripture Reflection for Teachers	Weekly reflections for staff, linking the Project Compassion stories to the Sunday Scripture readings. Use for weekly staff reflections during Lent or with secondary students.
	Way of the Cross (PPT)	Available in Primary or Secondary versions. A reflection following the Way of the Cross, to use during Holy Week. Leaders' Notes included.
Telling Others	Newsletter Notices	A brief insert for your weekly school newsletter, explaining the week's Project Compassion story. Include in print/online school communications. Use on school social media and website.
